Fellowship Application Questionnaire

- 1. This form must be filled out in its entirety.
- 2. Fellowship applicants must earn at least 100 points in order to be considered by the APC Fellowship Committee.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation by current APC Fellow. At least one letter must come from an external source and not the applicant's place of employment.
- 4. Proof of at least 30 hours compounding related CE (ex. download from NABP for date range March 1, 2021 through February 29, 2024).
- 5. Copies of any presentation or articles requesting points for.
- 6. Copies of any certificates from certificate programs requesting points for.
- 7. Submit a current CV and headshot.
- Submit a paragraph on how you apply APC's Code of Ethics in your practice/profession and how you have been involved in APC in the past and how you would use your Fellow designation to promote APC moving forward.
- 9. Submit to an Interview by the APC Fellowship Committee.
- 10. All applications must be submitted to APC by March 31, 2024.
- 11. Fellowship Inductions take place once a year at Compounders on Capitol Hill (CCH).

Category III – Compounding Related Continuing Education

A mandatory thirty (30) hours of compounding related CE must be earned in the three years prior to the application date (March 1, 2021 through February 29, 2024). Each CE credit hour is one (1) point. Applicants must provide documentation of at least 30 compounding-related CE hours (UAN designator -07 Compounding). Include a copy of your NABP CPE Monitor report for each point claimed for category III with compounding related courses highlighted. The CE program must be listed in the CPE monitor, a certificate of participation is not sufficient. If the CE does not have a -07 but is part of a compounding conference (ex. APC's EduCon) it will be considered compounding related. For all other CEs not listed as -07 provide a short justification on how that CE relates to compounding pharmacy below. You may provide more than 30 CEs for consideration, but they will not accrue additional points.

Category VIII – Teaching

Two points per year are permitted for each compounding related course taught by the applicant. To qualify, the educational activity must be a formalized course and affiliated with a college or technical school for health care professionals or an ACPE-accredited course through a professional company or organization.

This category also can consist of intern/externship/rotation programs provided by pharmacists and their pharmacy or a preceptor position with a university.
