

Challenge: Wound Care

- Compounded drugs are essential for treating patients whose therapy needs cannot be met by commercially available drugs.
- Compounded medications are well suited for conditions suffered by Medicaid beneficiaries – and can treat them cost-effectively.
- Most Medicaid beneficiaries do not have access to bespoke therapies for treating conditions in a way that serves to control costs rather than inflate them.
- This pilot will target wound care, including open wound with/out fungal/bacterial infections, as well as scars and scar pain.
