It was moved and seconded to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed.

## STRATEGY

A motion was made and seconded to approve launch of a voluntary compounding dispensing datagathering initiative in partnership with APC member pharmacies and in collaboration with Emory University Rollins School of Public Health Researchers, via which APC will release to policymakers, news media, and others aggregated dispensing data on compounded therapies; further, that \$31,500 annual cost be funded for the first 24 months from APC's earmarked Public Policy Fund.

## The motion was amended to:
